The Council Members at the October meeting voted to contract with Update Management, Inc. IEUCC Utilities are billed end of year for the tickets they received that year. There will be the same billing this year. But in the rest of WA State OCC bills the Utilities monthly for the tickets they received. The balance of these ticket funds is then sent to NUNC and UULC(WA811). The IEUCC will have that same “monthly” billing policy for 2026. Although, OCC raised their rates 20%, there was considerable discussion at this meeting and no decision to raise any Dues at this time.**
