

Kathy and Char Boykin announced last month that they will be retiring from the IEUCC Contracted Business position the end of 2025. At this time, the Council Board is leaning toward contracting with one of the companies that handle nonprofit association's affairs. Justin mentioned talking with Devries about digitizing and shredding some of the Council's records. Also, IEUCC Utilities are billed end of year for the tickets they received that year. In the rest of WA State OCC bills the Utilities monthly for the tickets they received. The balance of these ticket funds is then sent to NUNC and UULC(WA811). OCC raised their rates 20%, so it will likely be necessary to change cost per outgoing tickets to utility members. Per the IEUCC Bylaws it will be necessary for members to vote on whatever is decided.
